Learning Targets

English Language Arts (ELA): Daily 5 routines, Accuracy and Expand Vocabulary strategies, Read-to-Self, Work on Writing, and Read to Someone practice. Publishing and sharing our first writing pieces. Finishing the first Foundations Unit (reviewing digraphs, digraph blends, the /k/ sound, and closed syllables).

Math: Introducing addition and subtraction word problems. Vocabulary: put together, take apart, unknown number, addend, sum, total.

Social Studies: Continuing our "People Now and Long Ago" Unit by creating our own personal timelines (homework), analyzing artifacts, and discussing communication, transportation, and traditions.

Science: Continuing our "Think Like an Engineer" Unit with the story "Those Darn Squirrels." We will create model drawings for effective bird feeders.

Religion: Discussing an overview of the 7 sacraments. Vocabulary: sacrament, Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Eucharist/Communion, Confirmation, Holy Orders, Matrimony, & Anointing of the Sick.
