Learning Targets

English Language Arts (ELA): Introducing Listen to Reading. Working on our small moment personal narratives by adding temporal words, describing actions step by step, and adding character dialogue/feelings. Adding fluency strategies to the CAFÉ reading strategies board. Finishing the first Fundations Unit (reviewing digraphs, digraph blends, the /k/ sound, and closed syllables). Math: Continuing addition and subtraction word problems with compare word problems, mixed work problems, and special circumstance word problems. Vocabulary: more, fewer, comparison bars, compare, put together, take apart, unknown number, addend, sum, total

Social Studies: Finishing our "People Now and Long Ago" Unit by creating our own family trees (homework), and reviewing the unit content.

Science: Finishing our "Think Like an Engineer" Unit with the story "Those Darn Squirrels," and taking the unit assessment (Thurs, 9/27).

Religion: Discussing the seasons of our Church/"Liturgical" Year. Vocabulary: Liturgical, Ordinary Time, Advent, Christmas, Lent, The Three Days, & Easter. Specials: Scheduled as usual.
