### Learning Targets

English Language Arts (ELA): Publishing/sharing our small moment personal narratives. Continuing our new Reading Unit on Non-fiction texts, focusing on accuracy strategies. Starting Fundations Unit 3 (learning consonant suffix: -s, and vowel suffixed: -es, -ed, -ing, -est, and -er when being added to unchanging base words; Vowel Teams: oa, ow, ou, oo, ue ew, oe, ow, ou, oo, ue; & trick words: when, where, there, here, why, again, please, animal, sure, use, and used). Math: Continuing Unit 2 - Addition Within 200. This week we'll be using place value to compare numbers using greater than, less than, equal to symbols. We'll also learn new strategies for adding 2-digit numbers.

Social Studies: Continuing Unit 2 "The Land Around Us." Analyzing, discussing, and creating our own map grids and discussing urban, rural, and suburban areas. Vocab: map grid, column, row, urban, rural, & suburban.

Science: Continuing our Water & Landforms Unit by filling out a comprehensive landforms booklet and reviewing landforms with play dough.

Religion: Saint research and projects. Vocab: saint.
