## Learning Targets

**English Language Arts (ELA):** Introducing Listen to Reading. Working on our small moment personal narratives by describing the setting with our 5 senses, adding strong endings, and revising/editing. Introducing reading journals to extend our thinking. Starting Foundations Unit 2 (learning about bonus letters: ll, ff, ss, and sometimes zz; glued or "welded" sounds: all, am, an, ang, ing, ong, ung, ank, ink, onk, unk; r-controlled vowels: ar, er, ur, or, ir; and trick words (sight words/popcorn words): shall, pull, full, both, talk, walk).

**Math:** Continuing addition and subtraction word problems with compare word problems, mixed work problems, and 2-step word problems. Vocabulary: more, fewer, comparison bars, compare, put together, take apart, unknown number.

**Social Studies:** Finishing and testing on our "People Now and Long Ago" Unit.

**Science:** Beginning our Water & Landforms Unit by learning about where water is found on Earth and how scientists share this type of information.

**Religion:** Focusing on Ordinary Time and the Rosary in preparation for Friday's Living Rosary.
