Learning Targets

English Language Arts (ELA): Continuing our non-fiction writing unit, focusing on adding glossaries, examples, comparisons, adverbs, and varying sentence types. Finishing our non-fiction reading unit gathering information, comparing/contrasting tests, and discussing craft & structure. Finishing Fundations Unit 5 (reviewing how to spell and break apart multisyllabic words like cat/nip; learning new consonant suffixes: -ness, -less, -ment, -ful, learning new vowel suffixes: -able, -ish, -en; introducing Vowel Teams: au like August and aw like saw; & trick words: against, knew, know, always, often, once). Math: Reviewing Unit 2 Math Tests and Beginning Unit 3 - Length and Shapes. This week, we'll be focusing on measuring in centimeters and drawing different shapes. Vocabulary: centimeter (cm), length, line segment, horizontal, vertical, partner lengths, square, rectangle, angle, opposite sides, triangle, hexagon, pentagon, quadrilateral.

Social Studies: Reviewing landforms and important map locations in North America and preparing for our first Mystery Skype by finding fun facts about California.

Science: Beginning our "Earth Changes" Unit. This week, we'll focus on the questions: "What Shapes the Land?" and "How can layers of the Earth be modeled?" We'll even make our own edible models of the Earth's layers!

Religion: Whole Life Curriculum - focusing on life, purity, and social justice at a second grade level, including lessons on the following topics: I- You are special because God made you. 2- God created you to love Him. 3- We appreciate the special abilities God gave others. 4- We look for opportunities to love others as God does. 5- Jesus is the ultimate hero.
