## Learning Targets

English Language Arts (ELA): Finishing letter writing to inspire change in our community by publishing and sending our letters to various community leaders. Finishing our Characters Reading Unit by discussing morals and lessons from our stories. Finishing Fundations Unit 7 (introducing open syllables like: go, flu, we, introducing y as a vowel like: my, try, by, combining open syllables with closed and vowel-consonant-e syllables, learning additional syllable division rules, learning the y, ly, ty suffixes, trick words: eight, large, change, city, every, family, night,

carry, & something). Finishing DIBELS and DRA testing.

Math: Continuing Unit 4 - Subtract 2-Digit Numbers. This week, we'll continue to practice the Expanded Method and the Ungroup First Method of double-digit subtraction and start to

apply this learning to money problems.

<u>Social Studies:</u> Continuing Unit 4 - People in the Marketplace. This week, we'll be discussing modern farming in today's society. Vocab: technology, tool, product, & product map. <u>Science:</u> Continuing our "Éarth Chánges" Unit. This week, we'll be testing our own company plans to slow/stop erosion! We'll also be starting our final Earth Changes assignment, showing our cumulative learning from this unit.

Religion: Continuing our First Reconciliation preparation with Ch. 3, "Celebrating God's Forgiveness." Vocab: examination of conscience, contrition, & Act of Contrition. Saint of the Week: St. Thomas More.
