## Learning Targets

**English Language Arts (ELA):** Finishing our comic strips and beginning our realistic fiction stories. Continuing our nonfiction reading unit where we dive deeper into nonfiction reading and strategies, with a special focus on context clues. Finishing Foundations Unit 8 (focusing on r-controlled vowels ar and or spelling patterns, like fort, part, orbit, & party, trick words: world, answer, different).

**Math:** Continuing Unit 4 - Subtract 2-Digit Numbers. This week, we'll continue practicing the Expanded Method and the Ungroup First Method of double-digit subtraction and continue applying this learning to money and word problems.

**Social Studies:** Reviewing our Unit 4 "Using Our Resources" tests and beginning Unit 5 "People in the Marketplace."

**Science:** Beginning our "Biodiversity of Life" unit in preparation for March's zoo field trip. This week, we'll learn about habitats, biodiversity, and classifying animals.

**Religion:** Continuing our First Reconciliation preparation with Ch. 6, "Living God's Peace."
