## Learning Targets

Enalish Language Arts (ELA): Finishing our comic strips and beginning our realistic fiction stories. Continuing our nonfiction reading unit where we dive deeper into nonfiction reading and strategies, with a special focus on context clues. Finishing Fundations Unit 8 (focusing on r-controlled vowels ar and or spelling patterns, like fort, part, orbit, & party;

Math: Continuing Unit 4 - Subtract 2-Digit Numbers. This week, we'll continue practicing the Expanded Method and the Ungroup First Method of double-digit subtraction and continue applying this learning to money and word problems.
