## Learning Targets

**English Language Arts (ELA):** Continuing our realistic fiction stories, focusing on describing characters' actions, dialogue, and thoughts in lots of detail. Continuing our nonfiction reading unit by focusing on history texts this week. Finishing Foundations Unit 8 (focusing on r-controlled vowels ar and or spelling patterns, like fort, part, orbit, & party; trick words: world, answer, different). We'll also be starting Foundations Unit 9.

**Math:** Continuing Unit 4 - Subtract 2-Digit Numbers. This week, we'll apply our subtraction strategies to more complex word problems, including compare word problems.

**Social Studies:** Continuing Unit 5 "People in the Marketplace," learning about consumers/producers, goods/services, wants/needs, and different forms of currency, including checkbooks.

**Science:** Beginning our "Biodiversity of Life" unit in preparation for our zoo field trip. This week, we'll finish learning about animal classification and jump into research of our first habitat: the rainforest.

**Religion:** Reviewing all First Reconciliation content and preparing for Saturday's sacrament. Practicing the Act of Contrition, the Reconciliation script, and our lines for Saturday.
