### Learning Targets

**English Language Arts (ELA):** Continuing our reading and writing Poetry unit in preparation for SMA's Poetry Day next week on April 10th. Finishing Foundations Unit 10 (introducing double vowel syllables "ai" and "ay" like paint, train, spray, and display; learn about homophones like main/mane; trick words: great, country, away, America, school, though; and review trick words: another, none, nothing, people, month) and starting Foundations Unit 11.

**Math:** Continuing Unit 5, "Time, Graphs, and Word Problems." This week, we'll focus on picture graphs, bar graphs, and start our graphing project.

**Social Studies:** Continuing Unit 3, "Governing the People" and starting our Junior Achievement lessons.

**Science:** Finishing our "Biodiversity of Life" unit with our final project of the unit: habitat dioramas. We'll also begin our next unit on "Seed Dispersal & Pollination."

**Religion:** Continuing First Communion preparation with Chapter 4, "Liturgy of the Eucharist." Vocabulary: Liturgy of the Eucharist, paten, chalice, Last Supper, altar, sacrifice, Eucharistic Prayer, chalice, Consecration, & Real Presence. St. of the Week: St. Brigid.
