Learning Targets

Enalish Language Arts (ELA): Continuing our reading and writing Poetry unit in preparation for SMA's Poetry Day next week on April 10th. Finishing Fundations Unit 10 (introducing double vowel syllables "ai" and "ay" like paint, train, spray, and display; learn about homophones like main/mane; trick words: great, country, away, Americ**£**, school, though, and review trick words: another, none, nothing, people, month) and starting Fundations Unit II.

Math: Continuing Unit 5, "Time, Graphs, and Word Problems." This week, we'll focus on picture graphs, bar graphs, and start our graphing project.

Social Studies: Continuing Unit 3, "Governing the People" and starting our Junior Achievement lessons.

<u>Science:</u> Finishing our "Biodiversity of Life" unit with our final project of the unit: habitat dioramas.
