Learning Targets

English Language Arts (ELA): Finishing our reading and writing Poetry unit and beginning our Historical Fiction reading unit. Continuing Fundations Unit II (introducing vowel teams ee, ea, and ey for the long e sound like sheep, steam, and hockey; trick words: whose, won, son, breakfast, head, ready; and review trick words: little, been, want, Mr., and Mrs.).

Math: Finishing, reviewing, and testing on Unit 5, "Time, Graphs, and Word Problems." We'll also work on our final survey graphing projects!

<u>Social Studies:</u> Continuing Unit 3, "Governing the People" and continuing our Junior Achievement lessons.

<u>Science</u>: Continuing our "Seed Dispersal & Pollination" unit by studying various pollinating animals, with a special focus on bees.

<u>Religion:</u> Continuing First Communion preparation with Chapter 5, "Receiving the Body and Blood." Vocabulary: Holy Communion, Sign of Peace, Host. St. of the Week: St. Josephine Bakhita. We'll also start practicing how to receive Communion this week. <u>Specials</u>: No Music on Wednesday due to Poetry Day. Everything else-usual schedule.
