Learning Targets

English Language Arts (ELA): Daily 5 routines, accuracy strategies (use picture clues, use beginning/ending sounds, chunk words, skip word and come back to it, flip the sounds), expand vocabulary strategies (compound words), writing workshop routines, and Fundations Unit I (reviewing diaraphs. diaraph blends, the /k/ sound, and closed syllables).

Math: Doubles strategies and adding 3-4 addends. Vocab: double facts, expression, equation, equation chain, addend/partner, & total/sum.

Social Studies: Continuing our "People Now and Long Ago" Unit by creating our own timelines and sharing family artifacts. Vocab: storyboard, timeline, artifacts, ancestors, sources, & heritage.

Science: Finishing our "What is a Scientist?" Unit by learning about different types of scientists & starting Unit 2, "What Do Engineers Do?" Religion: Safe environments lesson and Chapter 3, "We Celebrate God's Love." Vocab: Catholics, parishes, Alleluia, faith, worship, & sacrament...
