## Learning Targets

**English Language Arts (ELA):** Finishing our Nonfiction Reading Unit, focusing on main idea and author's purpose this week. Finishing our nonfiction writing units by revising, editing, and publishing, and finishing Foundations Unit 4 (reviewing how to spell and break apart multisyllabic words like cat/hip; learning new consonant suffixes: -ness, -less, -ment, -ful; learning new vowel suffixes: -able, -ish, -en; introducing Vowel Teams: au like August and aw like saw; and trick words: against, knew, know, always, often, & once).

**Math:** Continuing Unit 2, Addition Within 200. This week we'll continue applying various addition strategies to money and begin applying to 3 and 4 addends. Vocab: pennies, dimes, dollars, regroup, new groups method, show all totals method, addends, sum/total.

**Social Studies:** Continuing Unit 2, "The Land Around Us" with preparation for our first Mystery Skype, which will be next week. We'll learn about CA, & review our map skills.

**Science:** Finishing our "Water & Landforms" Unit and beginning our next unit, "What Shapes the Land?"

**Religion:** Finishing our Baptism review, and beginning our chapters about God's Love and God's Laws. Vocab: saint, Original Sin, Baptism, grace, Bible, Old Testament, New Testament, Gospels, commandment, & Great Commandment.
