Learning Targets

English Language Arts (ELA): Finishing our Nonfiction Reading Unit, completing our study of main idea and author's purpose. Finishing publishing and sharing our nonfiction books, and finishing Fundations Unit 5 (reviewing how to spell and break apart multisyllabic words like cat/nip; learning new consonant suffixes: -ness, -less, -ment, -ful; learning new vowel suffixes: -able, -ish, -en; introducing Vowel Teams: au like August and aw like saw; & trick words: against, knew, know, always, often, once).

Math: Introducing Unit 3, Length and Shapes.

Social Studies: We will have one more Mystery Skype this week, where we utilize our mapping skills to figure out the home states of the classes we're Skyping.
