## Learning Targets

English Language Arts (ELA): Finishing our Fiction Reading Unit all about characters, focusing on predicting character's actions and identifying the lesson/moral of the story. Sending our letters for change & beginning our next writing unit on comics & realistic fiction. Fundations Unit 9 (focusing on r-controlled vowels er, ir, and ur spelling patterns, like burst, termite, dirty, and trick words: picture, learn, earth, father, brother, & mother). Math: Continuing Unit 4 Subtraction with 2-Digit Numbers. This week, we'll continue practicing with money as well as diving into addition/subtraction word problems. Social Studies: Continuing our "Using our Resources" Unit. This week we'll compare/ contrast farming long ago with modern farming and analyze product maps. Vocab: crops, tools, climate, product, product map, technology.

Science: Continuing our "Earth Changes" Unit by designing and testing our company plans to slow/stop water erosion.

Religion: We are continuing First Reconciliation preparation with Ch. 4, "Preparing to Celebrate Reconciliation." We'll discuss the components and steps of Reconciliation. Vocabexamination of conscience, contrition, confession, penance, & absolution. Saint of the Week-St. Thomas More. Please practice the Act of Contrition at home with your students.
