## Learning Targets

**English Language Arts (ELA):** Continuing our nonfiction reading unit (focusing on science texts this week) and continuing our realistic fiction writing unit (focusing on adding character's thoughts, words (dialogue), and feelings). Foundations Unit 11 (introducing vowel teams ee, ea, and ey for the long e sound like sheep, steam, and hockey; trick words: whose, won, son, breakfast, head, ready; & review trick words: little, been, want, Mr., & Mrs.).

**Math:** Continuing Unit 4 Subtraction with 2-Digit Numbers. This week, we'll practice more 2-step word problems, and begin to review the unit. **The Unit 4 Test will be this coming Monday, 3/9 and Tuesday, 3/10. Please help students review at home.**

**Social Studies:** Continuing our new unit, "People in the Marketplace." This week, we'll focus on consumers vs. producers, wants vs. needs, and goods vs. services.

**Science:** Continuing our new unit, "The Wonderful Biodiversity of Life," studying habitats, animals, and their adaptations. This is in preparation for our zoo field trip on 3/25!

**Religion:** We are finishing our First Reconciliation preparation for Saturday's big day! **Please practice the Act of Contrition at home with your students. They will need this memorized before First Reconciliation!**
